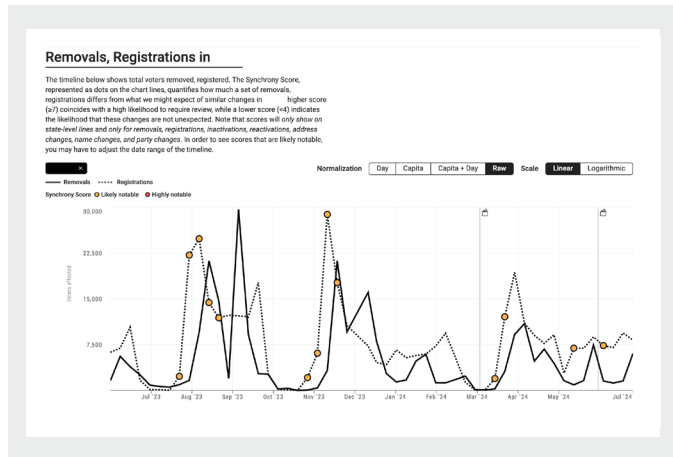

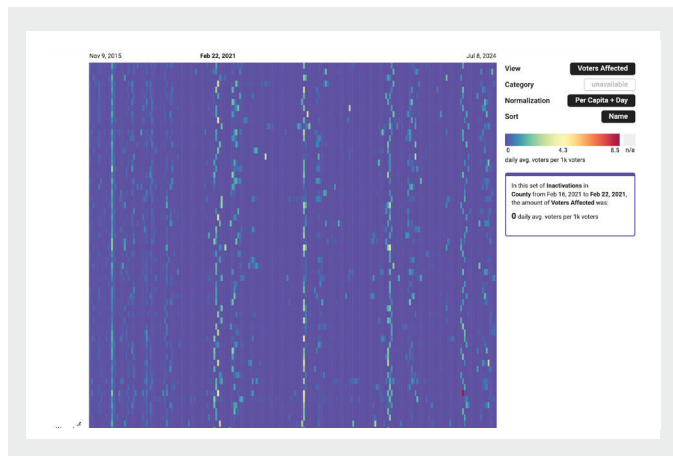

HOW IT WORKS:



We **observe** changes over time.

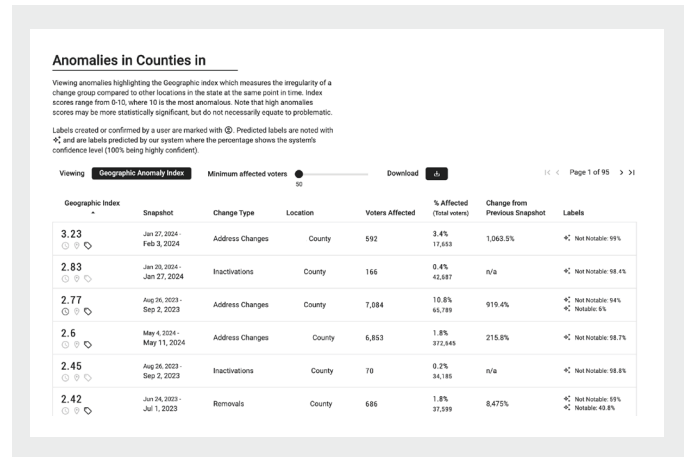
Every state makes voter data publicly available. VoteShield collects public voter files on a weekly or monthly basis, and looks for changes by comparing each snapshot to historical trends.



We **examine** statewide trends.

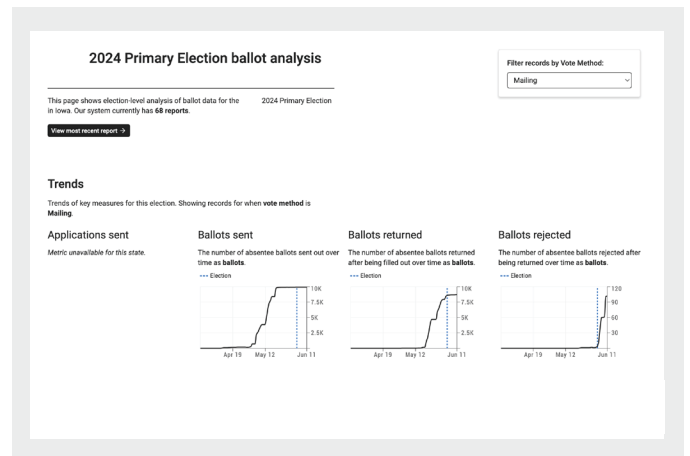
Visualizing years of changes to voter registration files across an entire state allows us to identify trends in pre-and post-election registrations, removals, address changes, and more.

We **detect** notable changes.

We use machine learning, and variables in the voter file itself like age and vote history, to spot minute changes across time and place.



We **track** absentee ballots.

We can review trends in returns, rejections, and track addresses with large numbers of absentee ballots.
